


The app's sole focus on **labour law compliance** was limiting and needed to expand the topics discussed during social dialogues between employers and trade unions














Most Selected Workers Priority Polls Sub-Topics



Top Prioritized Sub-Topics Selected by Young Workers (15 - 24 years old)




