# Introducing the survey

## Aims of the survey

The project Platform Workers: Decent Rights & Pay aimed to collect information to fill knowledge gaps in the area of rights and pay, for the benefit of platform workers in the Netherlands and abroad. While the platform economy is growing rapidly, knowledge about income and legal positions of platform workers lags behind, both among policy makers and platform workers themselves. Systematically gathered knowledge is needed to achieve improvements, preferably in dialogue with platform workers and their representatives. This includes collective bargaining agreements, contracts, remuneration systems, legislation and, a survey of platform workers in five countries, using the WageIndicator survey infrastructure and methodology. This codebook describes the details of the survey. Appendix 1 lists all questions and answers and their IDs. Appendix 2 lists all variables from the questionnaire as well as all variables generated from data in the questionnaire. Appendix 3 lists the codes of the country of residence and the country of birth of respondents.

## Outreach to a wide audience

The project aimed to use the collected data for outreach to the wider community of Platform workers and their partners. WageIndicator's outreach activities included customized webpages in the national WageIndicator websites, press releases, newsletters, and a range of social media activities. For many years WageIndicator has proven to be capable of attracting web traffic by means of search engine optimization, social media activities, posting teasers on the webpages, and alike.

## Fieldwork and questionnaire design

**Fieldwork** The fieldwork of the survey is described in detail in Korde et al (2021), page 14 and further for the five countries Argentina, India, Netherlands, South Africa, and Spain.

**Survey mode** The questionnaire was designed for use as a web survey. The survey was posted on the national WageIndicator websites and was made available on an app. These survey modes were used for telephone interviews, face-to-face interviews and web surveys. Note that in the telephone survey some questions were skipped for the sake of the duration of the interview.

**Survey pages** The questionnaire consisted of twelve pages:

- PAGE\_interviewer\_end

**Routing** The questionnaire included routing to ensure that no questions are asked to respondents to which the questions do not apply, e.g. only workers who work for a taxi platform are asked about their car and other workers are not asked about this topic.

**Anonymous** IP numbers were encrypted. The survey data does not allow to identify a single individual by name.

**Non-commercial** The survey had no partners who had a commercial interest in the data.

**API (Application Programming Interface)** For many years WageIndicator has been conducting continuous, multi-country surveys. To measure so-called long-list questions about education, region, occupation or industry, WageIndicator has developed API's for its surveys. These API's contain for example the educational categories in the national language relevant in the country surveyed and includes a bridging variable into the standard ISCED classification of the UNESCO.

**Variables** The questionnaire results in 126 variables, of which almost all are numerical and a few alphanumeric. In addition, another 80 variables are generated from these variables, such as size of the office workforce of the platform, private sector platforms, year, month/week/day of survey completion, higher aggregates from the API variables education, occupation and region, time stamps for each page in the questionnaire, variables indicating the device of the respondent, and a like.
