Introducing the WageIndicator web survey of platform-workers

AIMS OF THE SURVEY 'UNPAID WORK IN THE PLATFORM ECONOMY'

This survey focuses on unpaid work of platform workers. It aims to identify the incidence and intensity of unpaid activities as part of platform work and as part of household work. It also aims to specify the monetary implications of these unpaid activities. Research objectives are:

- 1) Do platform workers experience a wage penalty when performing a given volume of unpaid activities as part of the platform work?
- 2) Do platform workers experience a wage penalty when performing a given volume of unpaid housework activities?

The survey measures in detail the unpaid platform and household activities of platform workers, as well as their wages earned. It also includes survey questions aiming at measuring a few mediating variables.

SCOPE OF THE SURVEY

The UNPAID WORK survey is a volunteer web survey, posted at the frequently visited GIG platform pages of WageIndicator Foundation (see <https://wageindicator.org/labour-laws/platformeconomy>). Since a few years WageIndicator runs a short web survey for platform workers on this page. This survey partly overlaps with the UNPAID WORK survey, and will therefore be replaced by the UNPAID WORK survey. The UNPAID WORK survey is currently in English, but after approval of the survey it will be translated in Dutch and in Spanish, and a few languages to be decided later. The survey targets all countries where these languages are spoken.

One of the aims of the survey was to include the questions of the RESPECT web survey of a probability sample (<https://soc.kuleuven.be/ceso/wo/erlm/respectme>). The proposed survey to a substantial extent overlaps but had to reduce the number of questions, because respondents tend to drop out when non-probability web surveys are becoming too long.

DESIGN OF THE SURVEY

The web survey is designed in an excel spreadsheet, which is shown below. The web survey consists of 8 web PAGES, describes the ITEM TYPE (COL B), includes the MASTER QUESTIONNAIRE, displays a UNIQUE IDENTIFIER, the ROUTING through the survey, as well as the DATASET TYPE, distinguishing which items in the design feed into the survey's dataset.

WageIndicator has a survey platform available to run the survey, as well as a team of dedicated software developers. It has developed APIs for measuring countries, regions, occupations, educations and GIG platforms for some 200 countries and more than 50 languages. Since its start in 2001, WageIndicator is experienced in running web surveys, increasingly applying multiple-country/multiple-language surveys. In total, the WageIndicator web surveys have collected data from more than a million web visitors.

RECRUITMENT OF SURVEY RESPONDENTS

The survey will be promoted through social media, newsletters and websites. WageIndicator has extensive experience in social media outreach and also has a large email database that will be used to send out monthly GIG newsletters and a bimonthly general newsletter. Both channels will be used for recruitment in the target countries, namely 45 countries where Dutch, English, French, German, Portuguese and Spanish are spoken. Recruitment will continue for at least one year, and longer if possible. The link to the survey will be published regularly in newsletters and on social media during this period. The unpaid work survey will be visible on the gig platform pages of WageIndicator.org and on the platform economy focused website Gigpedia (gigpedia.org) for at least three years. Due to the rapid development of the internet and social media, WageIndicator cannot promise a certain number of completed questionnaires..

PRIVACY

WageIndicator applies a strict privacy regulation, according to the European GDPR legislation. In this survey no names, email addresses, or telephone numbers of survey respondents are asked.
