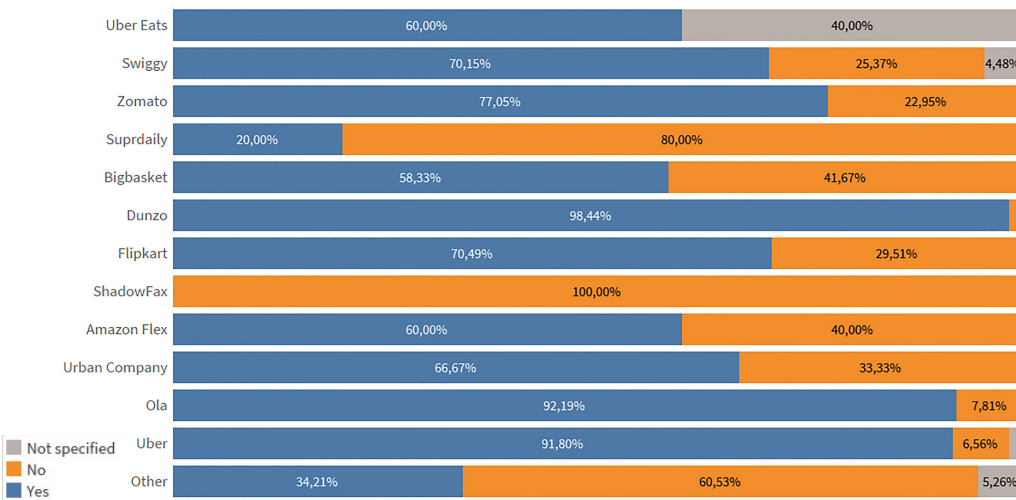

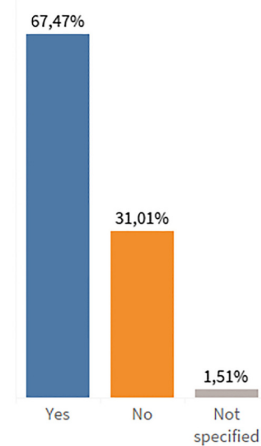
The Indian Platform Worker in this project

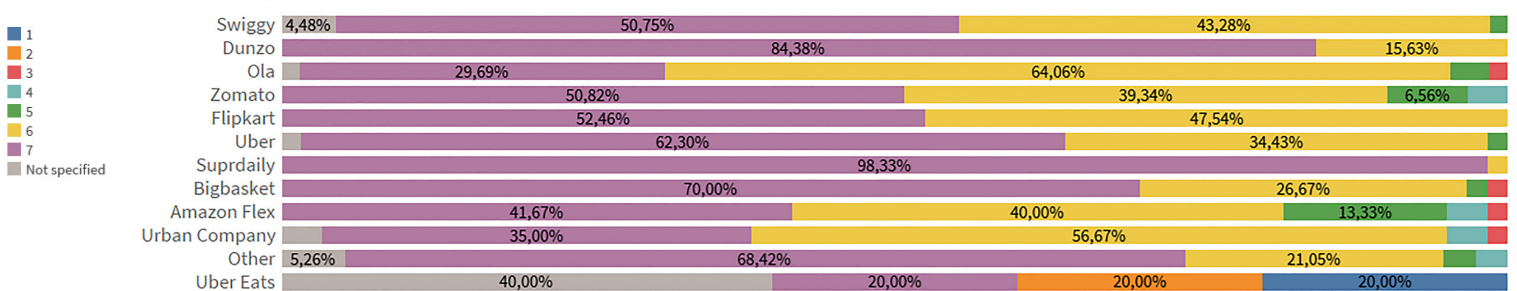
Workers with a contract (per platform)



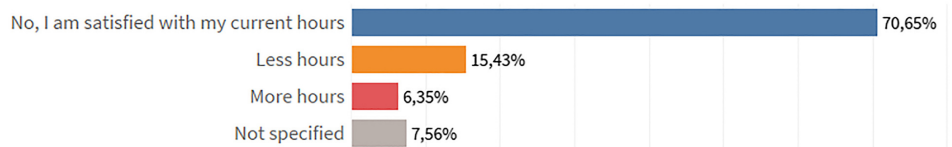
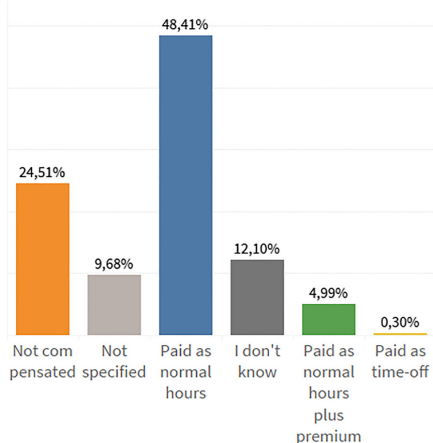
Do you work for a platform full-time?

Is your income likely to be unstable or uncertain?

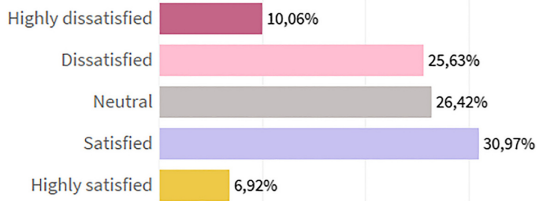


Do you receive your pay on time?

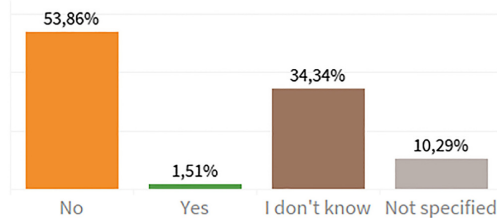


How satisfied are you with your pay?

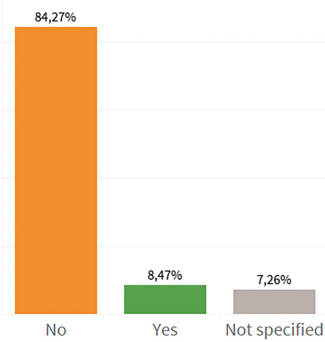

Is your work for a platform covered by a Collective Labour Agreement (CLA)?



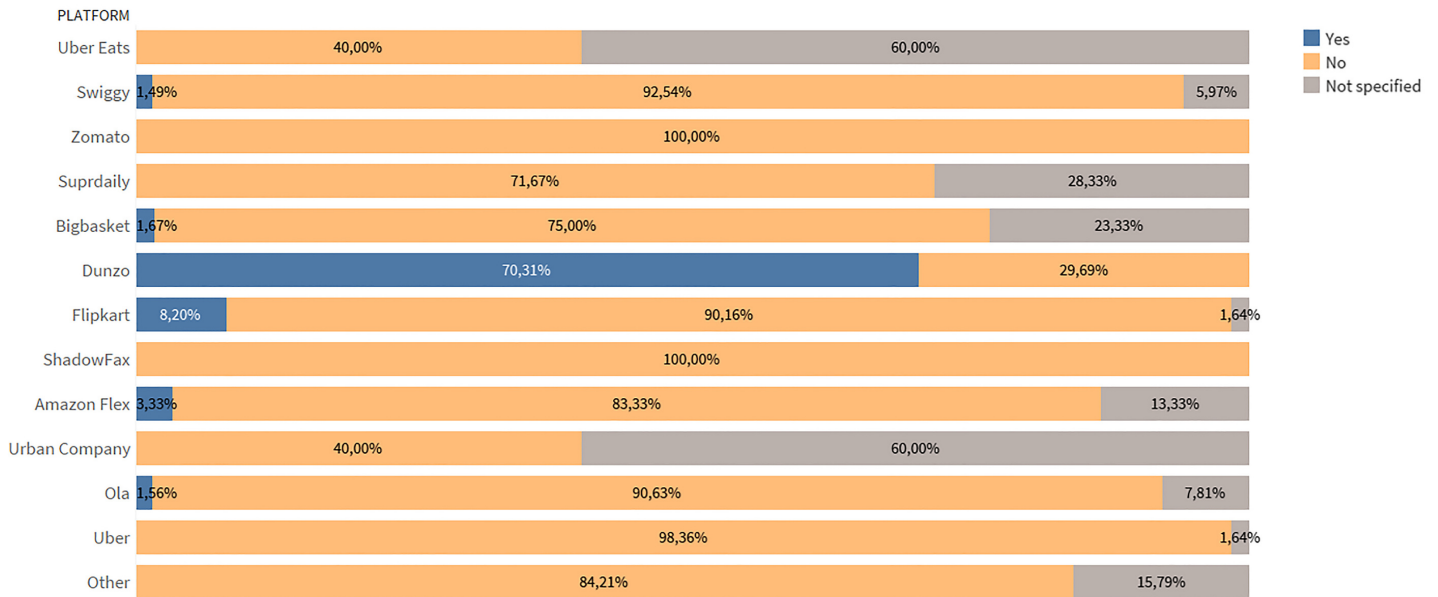
Does your platform provide paid sick leave?
