








Do you work for a platform full-time?



Would you prefer to work more or less hours per week




Where is your salary based on?




How many days do you work per week?




How satisfied are you with your pay?



If you work overtime, how is this compensated?




Is your income likely to be unstable or uncertain?




Do you receive your pay per week?

If not pay per month or week: On what payment period was your last pay based?




Does your platform pay contribution to a disability insurance for you?




Does the platform you work for provide training to acquire the qualifications?
